

Request for Letter of Intent to Apply

First 5 Plumas is requesting Letters of Intent to Apply for Grant Funding for the 2025-2026 fiscal year. Plumas County community partners are eligible to submit a Letter of Intent.

Letter of Intent due to first5plumas@gmail.com by May 16, 2025.

First 5 Plumas may have funding available for community projects that support the First 5 Plumas Strategic Plan (which is being revised for 2025-2030) with a focus on addressing gaps in services in Plumas County for families with children, ages prenatal to 5 years. First 5 Plumas Community Grant Funding may be available, up to a total of \$150,000 or as low as \$74,000 for <u>all</u> funded programs, dependent on funding allocations from First 5 California. Program managers will be notified about the status of their Letter of Intent and will be <u>invited to submit a Funding Proposal</u>, which will be due on Thursday, **May 29, 2025**.

If a proposal is approved by the First 5 Plumas County Children & Families Commission, Service Contracts may not be executed until after July 1, 2025.

Letter of Intent (one page) should include:

1. Agency/Program Name

2. Grant Amount (can include budget information). *Cannot be more than the previous funding level, if your program was ever funded by First 5 Plumas.*

3. Brief Project Description (can include information about service gaps/need for funding)

4. Brief plan for Measurable Outcomes

Note: Project Description can also include alignment with Strategic Priority Areas and Goals (see below).

Plumas Strategic Plan

Current Priority Areas:

1. Improved Child Health First 5 Plumas will provide support and advocacy to increase access to whole child health care.

2. Improved Child Development First 5 Plumas will increase exposure to parent education and knowledge of child development.

3. Improved Family Functioning First 5 Plumas will expand opportunities for all families to access social connections, knowledge, and resources through direct services, partnerships, and/or collaborations.

4. Improved Systems of Care First 5 Plumas will facilitate a coordinated effort to connect children and families to resources.
